

Bench Dedication at the Hingham Community Playground

The Hingham Community Playground is located at 330 Main Street, Hingham, MA with the entrance located to left of the Central Fire Station on Main Street. The fenced in playground is surrounded by tennis courts, a baseball diamond, soccer fields, a track and a roller hockey arena.

Founded in 2004, Su Escuela Language Academy has grown from one to over 200 students. Full Immersion programs in Mandarin and Spanish start with children as young as 9 months and continue through Junior-K, a program designed for children who are not old enough to attend Kindergarten, but are ready to progress with their education.
