This year at SELA, the Ecoamigos adventure continues with a focus on ecology. We will start by learning about the origins of our planet and move towards understanding the importance of taking care of it through recycling. Our students will explore the solar system and the different animal kingdoms, allowing them to understand their place in our ecosystem in a new and fascinating way. With an immersive Spanish curriculum and small classes grouped by age, our teachers foster curiosity and the joy of learning every day. We are excited to share this journey of research and experimentation with our students!

Children are provided with the opportunity to explore and learn about the world around them. Students in the summer program will be exposed to engineering, math, science, and technology concepts through experiments and creative activities. Additionally, students in the JrK-School Age programs are given access to ageappropriate digital materials.

SELA uses an app for parent-teacher communication, student authorization for dismissal, and attendance. Through this app, teachers provide parents with photos, videos, and updates regarding their child and classroom daily. Parents can also send messages to teachers & admin, mark that their child will be absent/arriving later, and enter dismissal permissions. Parents of infants and toddlers receive additional daily updates such as mealtimes, naps, and diaper changes. Details will be included in future summer communications for review.

#### Authorization for Student Dismissal

SELA uses an app to ensure safety and efficiency for a smooth child arrival and dismissal. It is used everyday at arrival and dismissal. Anyone helping with pick up and drop off for your child(ren) must have this app shared with them and be added by the parent to each individual child's profile as an Authorized Pickup. It is the parent's responsibility to add approved people to their child's authorized list through the app, prior to the child leaving the building.

New students will be added to the app in May and a detailed guide will be

provided for parents' reference.

#### Outdoor time

Every classroom has at least 30 minutes of outdoor gross motor time built into their daily routine within one of our 3 outdoor playgrounds. In the event of inclement weather, classrooms will utilize one of two indoor gym spaces for gross motor activities. Please be sure to send your child with safe and comfortable footwear every day. Flip flops/slides, high heels, and dress up shoes are discouraged.

**Potty Training** 

SELA does not have any restrictions or requirements on potty training, however we recommend that by the age of 3 students have at least started the process. As soon as your child starts showing signs of readiness at home, please reach out to your director or your child's teacher(s) in the app to see if they are also showing signs of readiness at school. Similarly, if your child's teacher(s) are noticing signs of readiness at school, they may reach out to you to see if you have noticed the same signs of readiness at home. We ask that you communicate in advance of starting the potty-training process, so that we can best support your child when they arrive at school.

#### Can my child attend if they do not know Spanish?

Of course! Every year we have many brand new students of all ages begin attending. Ways to support your child during their transition to this new environment:

- Stay consistent and positive!
- Talk to them about how exciting it is to go to a new school to play, meet new friends, teachers, and do projects. And about learning a new language and how they can always ask their teacher if they need anything at all.
- Listen to some of the common songs SELA uses in the classes, posted on our website
- Make sure you download the app to stay connected to your child's teacher. Please reach out to administrative staff with any other questions or concerns that

may come up.

#### Sunscreen & Hats

Communal sunscreen is provided for all students 6mos+ with parental consent.

Please send in a hat to remain in their cubby through the summer to always have on hand!

#### Health Policy

#### Water Play

Summer time is a great time to play with water! Here at SELA, we will do lots of activities involving water, however there is no need for bathing suits, towels or water shoes.

#### Refrigeration & Microwaves

SELA does not heat food up during the day, or offer refrigeration. Be sure to send a thermos for warm foods, and pack ice packs for foods kept cold.



### HOW TO REGISTER

Log in HERE, or use the QR code

Select your child's appropriate age group based on their age on the first day they are attending.



- Select your schedule.
  - Week by week, indicate the day combination first, followed by the timeframe.
  - If you also need AM/PM extended times, select the individual days first, followed by the total number of days.
  - o If you are waitlisted, please only select the number of days NOT waitlisted for.
  - As you build your schedule, you will see your total cost add up in your cart this is a great
    way to double check you've selected the correct schedule and is also where you are able to
    remove anything added by mistake.
- Complete Required Forms.
  - There are 3 forms that are required to be filled out at the time of registration. These may take you a few minutes to complete, so ensure you have that time set aside.
- Select a method of payment.
  - Payment in full is required at the time of registration for the summer program. Payments may be made via check, credit card, or ACH.
  - The 15% early reg discount will automatically be applied at checkout if you complete registration by 11:59pm March 3, 2025. Any days add to your schedule after this deadline will not include the discount. If you are registering 3 children, be sure to select the 3rd child discount. If you have any questions about discounts, contact accounting@suescuela.com.
- Receive confirmation
  - Once your payment is submitted, you will receive a confirmation email verifying that your registration is complete. Your child(ren)'s spot is now secured. Admissions and Accounting will review your registration and reach out if there are any schedule discrepancies.

#### Registration and Cancellation Policy

Please note that your child will not be able to begin the Summer Program until all of the required documents and your full payment is received. No payments are refunded upon voluntary termination of enrollment. If a child is removed from the Summer Program for any reason, any tuition that has been paid up to that point is non-refundable. SELA reserves the right to terminate this agreement if we determine that SELA is not the right program for the student. If this is the case, written notice will be given to the Parent/Guardian and a portion of the tuition may be refunded as decided by SELA.
